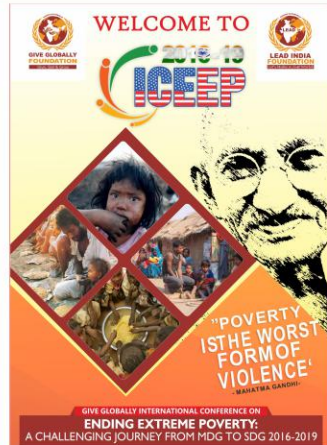


Ambulance Project

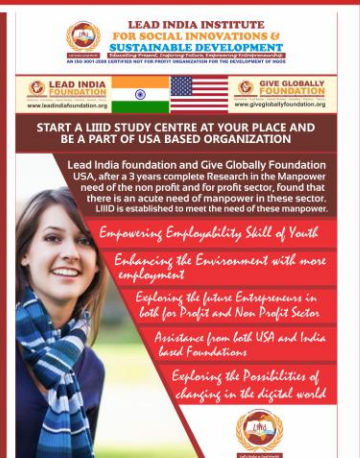

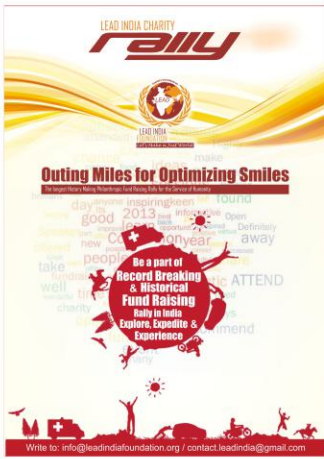

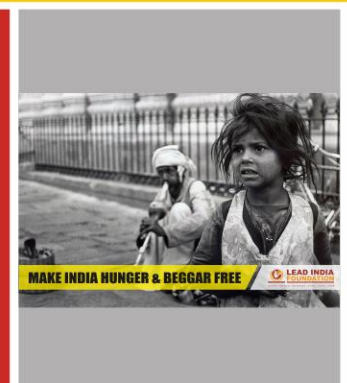
LIFE Club(Lead India Foundation for Educational Inclusion Club)

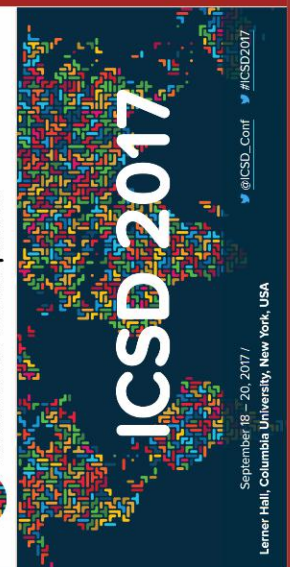

Giving Lectures at New York University to the classes from September SEP 18 - OCT 16

DIPLOMA IN MONITORING AND EVALUATION: PROJECT MANAGEMENT FOR THE UN, GOVERNMENT, AND NGOS This course will introduce students to the fundamentals of monitoring and evaluation (M&E). It will address questions such as: What is monitoring and evaluation? Why do it? Who does it? By the end of this course, students will be able to develop a monitoring and evaluation theoretical framework. Group work plays a significant role in this program and is required. If you are not comfortable working in groups, you may want to reconsider your participation in this program.



FROM NOV 2 - DEC 14 Giving Lectures at New York University Grant Proposal Writing

In this course, Giving Lectures to analyze the strategies and processes of writing an effective proposal to a foundation, corporation, or individual. Examine the elements and characteristics of a successful proposal, including information gathering, organization, and budget review. This course helps you focus on writing clearly and tailoring your proposal to the prospective funder. Throughout the course, complete weekly written assignments, culminating in a prototype grant proposal.
