The program is designed for individuals who want to be part of an intentional learning community of practitioners and scholars who are embedded in the field. It offers an integrated course of study that melds state-of-the-art leadership theory with proven management models, strategies and tools designed to teach professionals how to create and manage high-performance organizations.

The curriculum is focused on applied learning, which facilitates the transfer of knowledge from theory to practice. Each semester students produce organizational audits, governance documents, development plans, legislative campaigns, design research-based programs and evaluation models, and create community-organizing campaigns (among other products). In the process students learn how to be politically and technically proficient in bringing best practices to nonprofit organizations and philanthropies. Many of these products are housed in an online library of best practice resources used by thousands of practitioners across the country.

Points of Distinction

- Discounted tuition and scholarships for all students employed by 501(c)(3) or Indian Section 8 organizations.
- A student body comprised largely of nonprofit professionals who have proven leadership ability.
- Courses offered during evening hours and some weekend days, which allow students to work full time while attending the program. All the students will get stipend of to USD 500.
- A close-knit learning community that convenes regularly outside the classroom to build on the learning experience.
- Access to an active network of local professionals, including members of our advisory board, who represent some of the most prestigious public, private and nonprofit entities in the county.
- Students enrolled in the PGP in Nonprofit Leadership and Management are eligible to enroll in courses at the CPFR. These courses would count as elective units.
- Students enrolled in the CPNA program can get a Certificate in Nonprofit Management.

What can I do with this degree?

The goal of this program is to provide existing and aspiring nonprofit practitioners with practical tools that can be used to create successful nonprofit organizations. Alumni are assistant, associate and executive directors of nonprofits as well as consultants, executives, development officers, program managers and more.

Who should apply?

This program is appropriate for nonprofit professionals, many of whom will work full-time while completing the program. The program has a strong preference for applicants with at least four years of professional work experience.



Application Checklist

- The Give Globally Foundation Admission Application
- One official sealed transcript from all colleges and universities attended, including community colleges. Foreign transcripts must be accompanied by a Course-by-Course transcript evaluation from World Education Services (WES).
- A minimum of two professional letters of recommendation from current or previous supervisors, board chairs, or colleagues.
- A current resume or curriculum vita
- A 500-word statement of purpose answering the question: What do you believe are the greatest challenges facing the nonprofit sector (either locally or nationally) and how will what you learn in this program help you effectuate change in those areas?
- International applicants only: Official score reports for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

- Applicants whose Grade Point Averages are below a 3.00 (on 4.00 scale) should submit the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) General Test for consideration. For more information on preparing for the GRE, visit GGF's Test Prep or call +1 (917) 907-3208.

Education Requirements



- Applicants must complete a bachelor's degree prior to beginning the program. Applicants may apply prior to completing their bachelor's degree. In this case, please submit your most up-to-date transcripts, and if admitted, submit a second set of official transcripts after your degree is conferred.
- The minimum cumulative Grade Point Average is 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) in all undergraduate and graduate coursework.
- This program does not have any specific prerequisite courses.
